The East Butler Primary School Board has endorsed the schedule of Voluntary Contributions and Charges for 2026.

Voluntary Contributions

\$60 per child – The monies collected will be used in accordance with the School Education Act (1999) and School Education Regulations (2000) to supplement and enhance learning experiences for students. Although payments are voluntary, this money combined with government and non-government funding allows East Butler Primary School students to make the most of the programs and resources offered. Payments can be made through the personal use items list, direct deposit or any time throughout the year in person at reception.

Charges

These are costs associated with participation in incursions/excursions, special programs and optional activities for 2026. A breakdown of estimated charges has been provided in the 2026 Charges Schedule below. The table shows the **maximum** amount that can be requested during the school year.
